General info

- ASSESSMENT**
A system of continuous assessment is used, areas needing remedial attention are dealt with promptly. Assessments are done in four cycles followed by reports and then by feedback sessions with parents in interviews by appointment. This will be indicated in the term planner.
- AWARD CEREMONIES**
Grade R holds a ceremony at the end of the year to celebrate the special events and achievements of the past year. This event will be mentioned in newsletters and term planners. Parents are invited to attend.
- REPORTS**
Reports are issued four times a year. They are handed to parents at feedback meetings, and posted to children not at school at the end of the year.
- PRIMARY SCHOOL**
Progression to the MPS Primary school is not automatic. Screening will take place before the Grade 1 year.
- SCHOOL FEES**
Please contact our school office for an Enrollment Form which includes school fees information.
- STATIONERY, CONSUMABLES & OTHER FEES**
A once-off payment is made in the beginning of the year for baking, sensory, arts, crafts and first aid items. The cost of extra events can be paid as a once-off annual fee by the end of January, or per event by their due dates.
- NEWSLETTER**
A class newsletter is sent out weekly. It is our primary means of communicating important information to parents and therefore ask that parents read this newsletter.
- TERM CALENDAR**
A planner is issued each term in the newsletter with the dates of activities and events planned for the term. Please display it in a prominent place and add any additional dates as they are announced.

- OUTINGS**
Pre-primary has no outings but we get a lot of visitors e.g. Lilly-Put players.
- SSC (SCHOOL SUPPORT COMMITTEE)**
This assists the school with arranging events, fundraising, catering, etc. All parents are automatically members.
