- A** INDIVIDUAL LESSONS
 R565 /month per instrument
- B** DOUBLE LESSONS (as recommended by the teacher)

 R565 /month per instrument
- D** SUBJECT MUSIC PUPILS - Grades 7,8 & 9
 R565 /month: one practical lesson per week & theory classes
 R1 130 /month: two practical lessons per week & theory classes
- E** DRUMS (DRUM KIT) These lessons are offered by a private teacher.
 R590 /month - one lesson per week
- F** GROUP TUITION IN RECORDER
 At least two pupils are grouped, according to their level of development and previous experience. It presents an opportunity for pupils who can already play piano or keyboard, to start playing a wind instrument.

PAYMENT

Fees are due once a pupil has been accepted. Placing of pupils is subject to selection by the music staff and availability of a suitable lesson time. You will be notified as soon as the application has been processed. Invoicing will be based on assigned lesson time and it will be the responsibility of the pupil and/or parent to ensure attendance.

DISCONTINUATION OF LESSONS

If you intend terminating lessons, notice should be given in writing. If lessons are discontinued before the end of a month, a full months fees still apply.

NUMBER OF LESSONS

- A maximum of 16 lessons will be given per semester.
- Grades 4 - 12 learners will receive no lessons during exams.
- If your child is sick the lesson can be made up if you organize it with the teacher yourself and if the teacher is able to fit the lesson in to their timetable.
- Lessons missed due to school outings will not be made up.
- Each teacher commits to give as many lessons in a term as possible in relation to what the term program allows.
